Having thus completed training, Dr. McBride joined Hampshire Orthopedics in March 1996 where he has been in practice ever since.

Since joining Hampshire Orthopedics, Dr. McBride has been significantly involved with orthopedic sports medicine care with our community as well as at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst. In addition to providing routine orthopedic consultation at our main office, now in West Hatfield, he also provides care once weekly at the University Health Services, and orthopedic athletic injury care at UMass training room facilities. In addition Dr. McBride, along with Dr. Kurtis, provides sideline football coverage for UMass.

Dr. McBride has been board certified by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery since 1998. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgery.
